Policy

Ruh Early Years has developed safe procedures and practices to ensure children's health and safety is maintained and promoted to prevent the spread of any infection. Our early childhood education professionals are committed to creating a safe and healthy environment where children can learn, thrive and have safe access to childcare.

Procedure

In order to ensure the setting maintains a high standard of health and safety, the centre has developed the following procedures that all Early Years professionals must follow:

- Toilet and nappy changing procedures
- Screening procedure on arrival.
- Hand Sanitizer policy
- Handwashing
- Medication policy and procedures
- Procedures for the arrival and collection of children
- Fire evacuation procedure

- Supervision of children
- Risk assessments
- Recording accidents
- Food
- Allergies
- Fire safety
- Toys, resources and equipment
